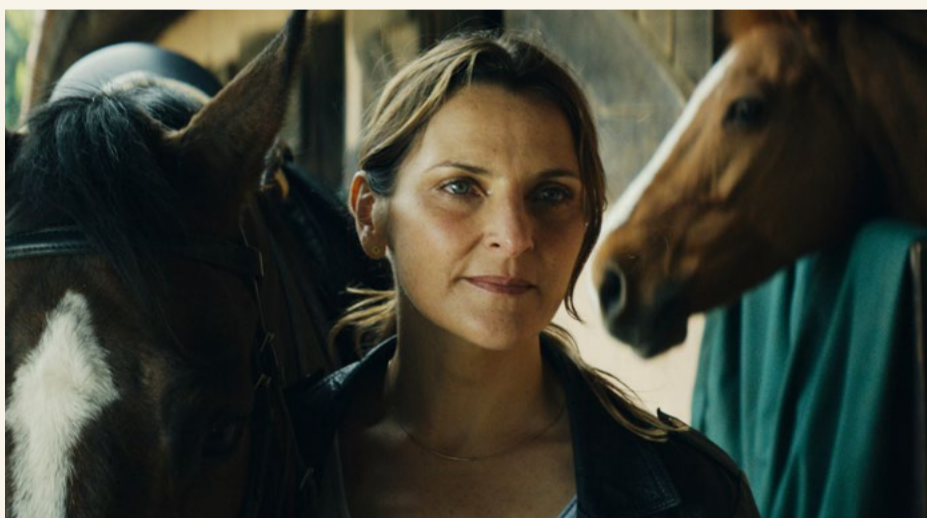

SYNOPSIS

Mariana (42) is a member of the Chilean upper class that takes privilege for granted. Scorned by her father and neglected by her husband, Mariana occupies her days running an art gallery and learning to ride a horse. Her riding instructor, Juan (60), is a former cavalry officer known as The Colonel who is under investigation for human rights abuses committed decades before. When Mariana embarks on an affair with her enigmatic teacher, she is for the first time directly confronted with the outrages of the dictatorship, as her interest threatens to tear down the invisible walls protecting her family from the past.
